As Writers ...

We will explore beating a monster story and explanation texts. The children will have the opportunity to write in these contexts as well as producing dialogues, explanations, reflections and narratives in different settings.

Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation will focus upon:

- Suffixes
- Verb Prefixes
- Modal verbs
- Adverbs for possibility.
- Common Exception Words

As Readers ...

We will be exploring a variety of texts from a wide range of sources to develop our reciprocal reading skills and to support our understanding of the wider curriculum.

Through this we will develop our ability to:

- Recognise themes within and across texts and make links to build upon understanding.
- Infer characters feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions.
- Explore the steps to success in order to retrieve facts from a text.
- Explore a range of language, synonyms, antonyms and its meaning in context.
- Make predictions about what we are about to read and summarise what we have already read

As Mathematicians ...

We will be implementing the White Rose scheme of work.

This outlines small steps of success (teaching fluency, problem solving and reasoning) for each of the areas of the curriculum outlined for Year 5.

- Place value, reading and writing of numbers to 1,000,000.
- Comparing and ordering numbers to 1 000 000
- Rounding numbers.
- Add and subtract numbers with more than four digits,
- Multi-step addition and subtraction problems.

As Geographers...

Children will begin by recapping on human and physical features of the UK before moving on to explore South America focusing specifically on a region in North Brazil. This will involve learning about biomes, climate zones and vegetation belts of the region. Children will learn about physical processes of rivers, mountains and the water cycle and apply this to the East Midlands and the North Region of Brazil.

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As Scientists ...

We start the term as physicians focusing upon forces and mechanisms. The areas we develop our skills and knowledge in are:

- Gravitational forces.
- Air and water resistance
- Friction
- Levers, pulleys and gears.

As Designers...

We will create a functional pop-up story book design, linking with our Science work by using levers, sliders, layers and spacers to create mechanisms.

We will be

 Revising our knowledge from Year Four and moving onto a learn about our pets.

In PE we will be...

Developing our personal skills learning to persevere at task and improve a performance whilst seeing new challenges as opportunities to learn

In Tag Rugby, we will develop our awareness of tactics and good team work whilst developing our skills in finding space, throwing and catching the ball.

Using our Computing skills...

We will be developing our knowledge of search engines by:

- Using efficient methods to find the information needed
- The importance of being critical and checking the validity of information.
- Learn how to create an information text crediting the source of images.

In RE we will be studying...

What does it mean if God is holy and loving?

- Making connections between biblical texts and Christian ideas of God.
- Think how Christians put their beliefs into practice through worship.
- How for most Christians, getting to know God is like getting to know a person.
